All the variables mentioned in this document are taken from (a subset of) the Irish National Election Study of 2020. The original data set and the full documentation of the variables can be found at:

The variable descriptions are in the codebook file and the original questionnaire can also be found in this repository. It is crucially important to **look up the precise formulation of the survey question** for each variable you use in your assignment in the original questionnaire! Do not rely on the description in this document to interpret your graph - it is only a crude description to allow you to choose which variables are of interest to you.

Note that the dependent variable must be selected from List A and the control variable must be selected from List C. The main explanatory / independent variable can be chosen from either List A or List B.
